

From August 12 to 22, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 411 likely voters in North Carolina's 74th State House District using SMS, live caller, and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±5 percentage points.
